The above program has been implemented in Noonkopirr location in Oloosirkon /Sholinke ward, Kajiado East Sub County by Ujamaa, an NGO supported by Victoria Porter from Australia.

The program targets school going children in primary school and women, the main area of support; training on life skills to prevent Gender based violence, water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) based activities -distribution of sanitary towels to the women and girls. The training allowed them to understand the inner workings of their own puberty evolution, sexual hygiene and how to get away if approached by a stranger for goods in exchange for sex.

The program has a future plan of training community volunteers, staff and provision of dignity kits for the boys as well as girls this will assist in ensuring sustainability.

Kitengela Sub - County hospital has over 100 community health volunteers with a catchment of upwards of 58,167 people, and serving over 33,340 patients quarterly.
